

Author's Letter of Consent with BOOKSHARE.ORG

Introduction and Definitions

BOOKSHARE.ORG is an Internet based electronic book library whose primary mission is to obtain and distribute reading material in specialized formats, exclusively for use by blind or other persons with print-related disabilities. These accessible materials are referred to in this Letter of Consent as "Books."

BOOKSHARE.ORG is a project of Beneficent Technology, Inc., ("Benetech") a California nonprofit corporation recognized under §501(c)(3) of U.S. tax law as a charitable organization. Benetech is funded by user fees, various private sources and governmental grants.

BOOKSHARE.ORG is an "Authorized Entity" permitted under §121 of U.S. copyright law to distribute Books within the U.S., as an express statutory exception to normal copyright restrictions on copying and distribution. **BOOKSHARE.ORG** also makes tightly controlled distributions of Books in specialized formats outside the U.S. to people with similar disabilities, pursuant to explicit written permissions from Authors and publishers, such as this Letter of Consent. The copyrighted Books are made available to **BOOKSHARE.ORG**'s users under a digital rights management plan intended to restrict the use of the Books to people with bona fide disabilities and discourage abuse.

_____, ("**AUTHOR**"), is an Author of books or holder of relevant intellectual property rights. **AUTHOR** wishes to cooperate with **BOOKSHARE.ORG** to better serve people with disabilities, around the world. **AUTHOR** also shares **BOOKSHARE.ORG**'s strong commitment to operating in full compliance with relevant local and international copyright laws and within the purview of the private contractual permissions, in the process of providing these services and regarding the use of the Books.

Together, **BOOKSHARE.ORG** and **AUTHOR** make this agreement to advance their common goals of assisting people with disabilities, within the statutory and contractual limitations noted.

TERMS

AUTHOR is hereby voluntarily agreeing to assist **BOOKSHARE.ORG** in its mission of enabling access to **AUTHOR**'s Books for people with disabilities who reside both inside and outside the United States.

AUTHOR hereby grants permission to **BOOKSHARE.ORG** to:

1. Provide accessible versions of books published by **AUTHOR** to people with qualifying print disabilities, either directly or in conjunction with other nonprofit or government agencies that serve people with disabilities, all over the world, except for those Books as to which **AUTHOR** specifically advises **BOOKSHARE.ORG** that **AUTHOR** does not control world rights. In such case, **AUTHOR** will advise **BOOKSHARE.ORG** of those countries to which this Consent does not apply.

2. Utilize **AUTHOR'S** Books in digital form available from whatever legitimate sources they can be obtained; for example, Amazon.com and Google scanning projects as well as from **BOOKSHARE.ORG** volunteers.
3. Work with staff and volunteers to improve the accuracy of the content, for example by adding structure markup, figure descriptions, Braille formatting and correcting transcription errors, to make the accessible reading experience more like the print reading experience.

AUTHOR represents that **AUTHOR** holds the relevant copyright or distribution rights for **AUTHOR'S** Books, and **AUTHOR** represents that it is acting within the scope of **AUTHOR'S** rights to provide such Books to **BOOKSHARE.ORG**. Books that are within copyright will be made available only to users with qualifying print and reading disabilities, using the definition of disability as set forth in section 17 U.S.C. § 121 of the U.S. copyright laws or similar laws in other jurisdictions, and will be subject to the same digital rights management systems as other copyrighted Books.

BOOKSHARE.ORG will, at its own expense, make versions of these Books available through its web site. Prior to making these Books available, **BOOKSHARE.ORG** will insert a "boilerplate" section in the front of them that outlines the legal limitations of the use of the digital book, and states the copyright status of the Book as being available only to people with bona fide print related disabilities.

If **AUTHOR** has made or should make an agreement with a third party for scanning of **AUTHOR'S** Books, such as Amazon.com, Google or service bureaus, this Letter of Consent may be provided to such third party as authorization for the provision of these Books to **BOOKSHARE.ORG**. This Letter of Consent by itself does not create an obligation on such third parties to cooperate with **BOOKSHARE.ORG**. **AUTHOR** may provide Books at no cost directly to **BOOKSHARE.ORG**, and agrees that the costs (if any) incurred by **AUTHOR** in providing these Books to **BOOKSHARE.ORG** will be borne by **AUTHOR**, unless compensation for these costs is agreed upon in writing by both parties prior to the expenditure. Similarly, **BOOKSHARE.ORG** shall receive no compensation from **AUTHOR** for making the Books available in digital form for download from the **BOOKSHARE.ORG** website.

AUTHOR shall have no responsibility for errors in the Books and associated digital files provided to **BOOKSHARE.ORG**.

This Agreement will remain in effect until terminated by either party on ninety (90) days prior written notice. Termination of this Agreement will result in loss of **BOOKSHARE.ORG'S** ability to provide these Books globally, from and after the date of termination, but shall have no effect on its authorized activities prior to that date. However, as long as **BOOKSHARE.ORG** is in compliance with U.S. copyright laws, it may continue to provide the Books to the extent that utilization is permitted by section 17 U.S.C. § 121 of the U. S. Copyright Act.

This agreement may be assigned by **BOOKSHARE.ORG** with 30 days advance written notice to **AUTHOR**, but only to a U.S. charity or nonprofit agency which qualifies as an authorized entity with a primary mission to serve the disabled under section 17 U.S.C. § 121.

Neither party shall be liable to the other under any circumstances for any direct or indirect, incidental or consequential damages nor for expenses of any kind, including, without limitation, loss of profits, legal fees and costs or otherwise.
