



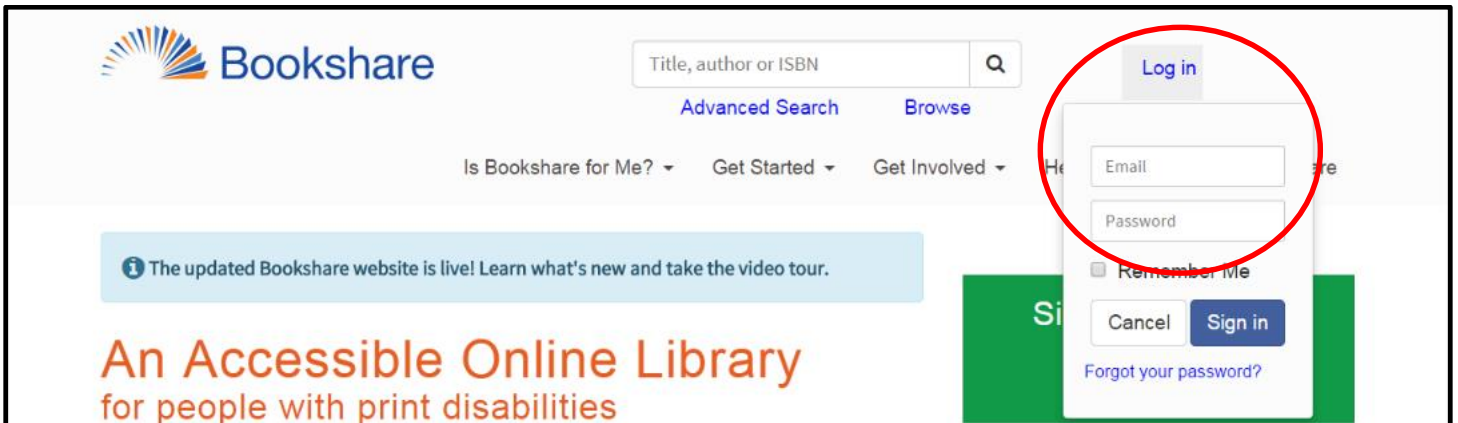

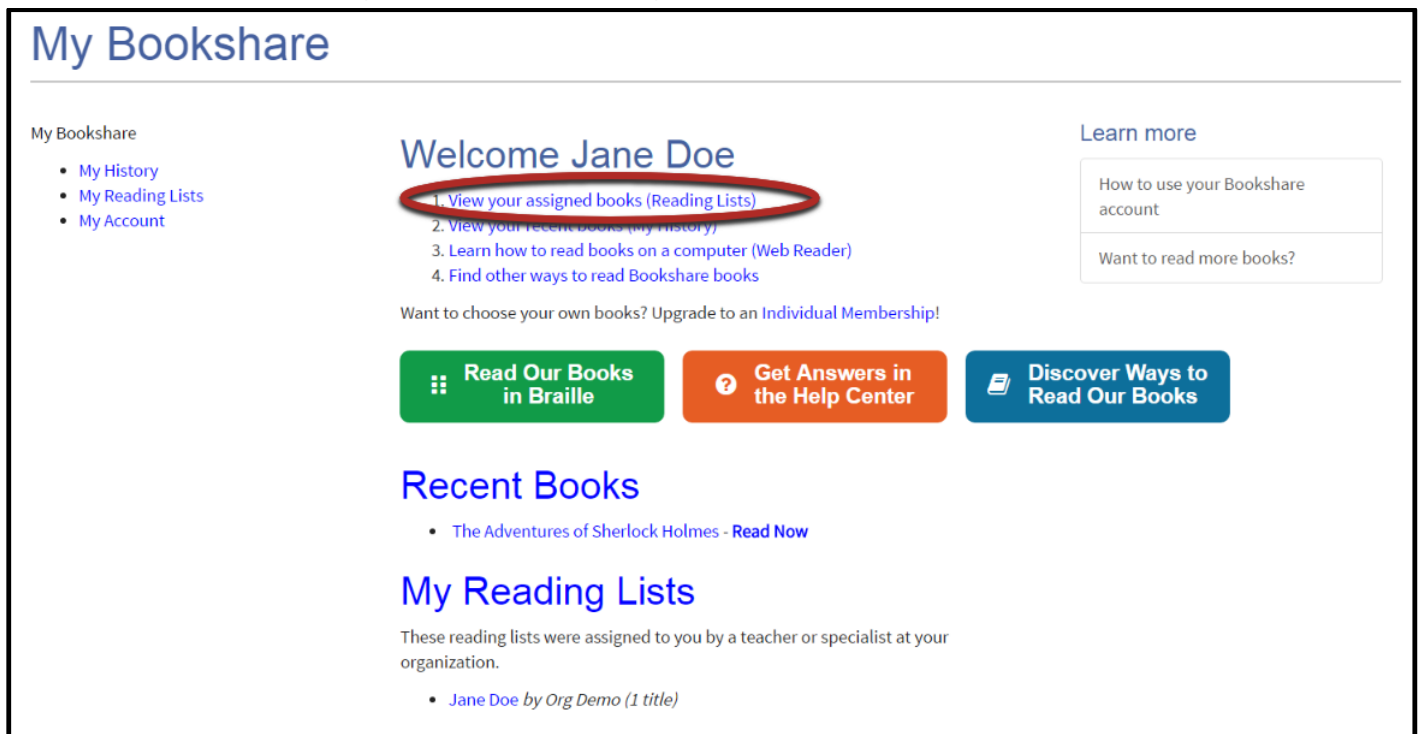


Read Bookshare Books on Your Computer


1) Log in to your [Bookshare account](#) with your username and password.



2) Select "View your Assigned Books (Reading Lists) in the top middle section of the screen.



3) Find the book you wish to read and select "Read Now."



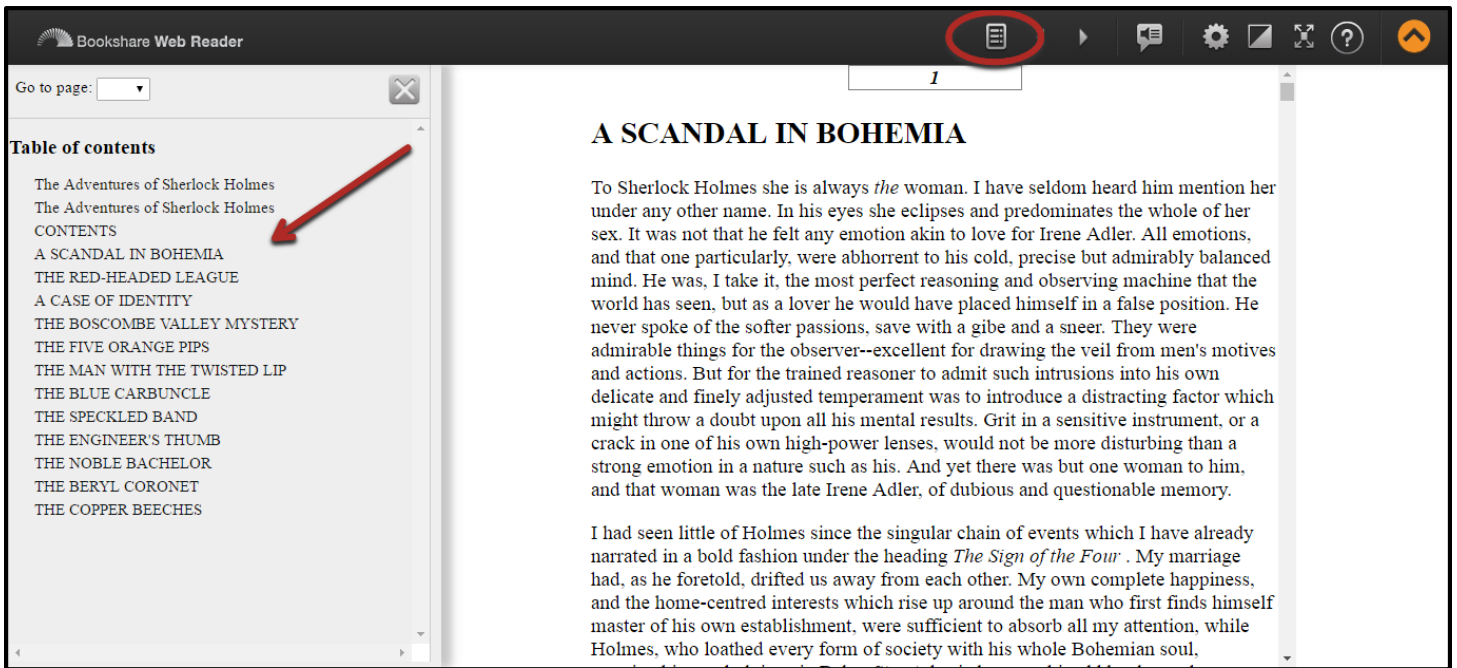

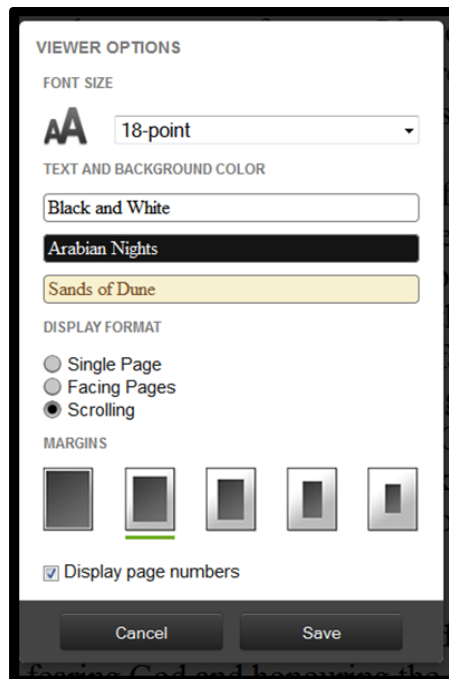

Read Bookshare Books in a Bookshare Integrated Application

1) Log in to a compatible reading application (visit the [Member Preferred Reading Tools](#) page for a partial list) and search for your book.

Note: In Voice Dream Reader and Capti Narrator, you can see in “History” the books that have recently been downloaded for you or that you opened in Bookshare Web Reader.
